Required Materials:

- Agreement to outline "Agreements and Responsibilities"
- A paragraph written by a parent/guardian explaining the scholarship's benefit to the student applicant.
- A paragraph written by the student applicant (or with adult assistance for younger students) expressing their enthusiasm for the program.
- A copy of the first page of your previous year's tax return (social security numbers should be redacted or blacked out).

Please Note:

- Applications will not be accepted until all required materials are complete.
- Scholarship award does not guarantee program enrollment.
- Program space is limited, and a separate registration may be required.
- Applicants will receive an email notification regarding the status of their application.
- If an instrument accompanies your scholarship, you must sign an "Instrument Rental Agreement" for the duration of the program. (A separate form will be sent)

SCHOLARSHIP AGREEMENT AND RESPONSIBILITIES

This Scholarship Agreement ("Agreement") is between Arts & Learning Conservatory ("ALC"), and the Parent/Guardian of "Student", an individual who is a student at ALC.

I. A. Participation Under Terms and Conditions of the Scholarship Program.

Student may continue as a Scholarship recipient for so long as Student satisfies all Program Conditions and the terms of this Agreement. Student affirms that the Program Conditions include, though are not limited to:

- I.A.(1) Student forfeits eligibility and will forfeit a Scholarship if Student is suspended from the program for any conduct-related activity, or if Student withdraws, or is dismissed from the program;
- I.A.(2) Within 48 hours of receiving scholarship, student must register for class/production using the scholarship fund. An email will be sent out with registration link.
- I.A.(3) The student is required to attend all classes/rehearsals/performances/recitals that are scheduled for their chosen program/class. Failure to do so can result in termination of scholarship.
- I.A.(4) The student is required to show up to classes/rehearsals/performances/recitals with enough to prepare for class.
- I.A.(5) It is mandatory to complete the scholarship survey, questionnaire, and progress report, along with pictures and videos of the student performing/rehearsing upon completing the class/program. A questionnaire/survey will be sent.
- I.A.(6) if the student fails to meet any of the above requirements, the scholarship will be revoked, and the student will be responsible for paying 5% of the scholarship amount.

I. B. Additional Obligations of Student.

In consideration of Student's receipt of a Scholarship, Student shall:

- **I.B.(1)** use Student's best efforts to dedicate adequate time to studies funded by the Scholarship.
- I.B.(2) permit ALC to use students' story, image, or likenesses for grant writing purposes and materials promoting ALC.
- I.B.(3) use Student's best efforts to dedicate at home practice to be prepared for class/production and report hours practiced per week on a weekly or monthly basis.
