**Production Update**

The team at Arts & Learning has been monitoring the fast-moving situation with the coronavirus. In order to further protect the health of our performers and their families, we will postpone the production of School of Rock. I am working with the theater to secure a new date for the production and will follow up as soon as state and local health officials provide guidance that it's safe to reconvene and a new date can be secured. This was a difficult decision to make – we know how hard our actors have worked on this fantastic show! However, the health of the ALC community is important to all of us – and our rescheduled performances will give our cast and crew a chance to shine!
