**GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES**

Arts & Learning is accepting applications for Costumers that are outgoing, detailed oriented and child-focused to costume a school play or play workshop over the course of 8-10 weeks. Costumers meet with the cast during scheduled rehearsals and assist at shows.

**Director Duties:**

**PRE-SHOW**

- Meet with Director to formulate a show concept and rehearsal schedule that works for all concerned artists.
- Script breakdown and costume plots (sketches/renderings of the costumes).
- Maintains accurate receipts.
- Selects and procures all materials, costumes, and accessories for costumes.
- Communicates with the director.
- Determines the visual look/concept of costumes in conjunction with the Director.
- Organizes work and storage areas and manages inventory of costumes.
- Arranges for maintenance/ transportation, and replacement of costumes.

**POST-PERFORMANCE**

- 1) Actively collects and returns costumes.
- 2) Attend post-show evaluation (if one is required)

**Job Requirements:**

- AA degree in design or theater, or courses to meet requirements.
- Exceptional costuming experience.
- Treat everyone with fairness and respect.

**Stipend:**

School play: Range \$500-900 8-10weeks

Production: \$900-\$1,000 - 12 weeks

The stipend is commensurate with play needs.
