GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES

Arts & Learning is accepting applications for Music Teaching Artists (vocalist) that are outgoing, detailed oriented and child focused to train, leading to a production over the course of 12 weeks. Music directors direct, and meet with the cast 3 times a week at 2-4hrs. of instruction per class with three extended Saturday rehearsals.

Director Duties:

PRE-SHOW

- 1) Meet with Director to formulate a show concept and rehearsal schedule that works for all concerned artists.
- 2) Attend all subsequent production meetings with directors.
- 3) Audition cast with production team.
- 4) Schedule and lead music rehearsals.
- 5) Prepare all needed music materials (with director's/producer's approval) for production.
- 6) Supervise musicians when called for respective rehearsals.
- 8) Conduct at music rehearsals. Evaluate rehearsal, and give notes to director.

POST-PERFORMANCE

- 1) Attend and be an active part of STRIKE.
- 2) Attend and be an active part of post-show evaluation.

Job Requirements:

- BA degree in Theater, or courses to meet requirements.
- Exceptional teaching experience.
- Encourage and develop confidence in students with patience.
- Treat everyone with fairness and respect.
